#### Ensure Your Children are Returning to School with their Feet in Tip Top Shape!

Moreover, when younger patients come in for foot care, there are certain conditions that we see more commonly due to growth and development problems and personal lifestyles. Some of the most common pediatric foot disorders include abnormal foot development, ingrown toenails, and fungal infections.

**Abnormal Foot Development** - In infants and young toddlers, there is an array of "regular" foot appearances. As a baby, the arches of your feet may not be clearly defined. Once a child begins taking his or her first steps, it is key to pay attention to how they move. Flat feet or in-toeing are two problems that can be corrected if handled early on. If you notice any abnormalities with their gait, it is essential that you visit a podiatrist. They will examine and detect abnormalities and, in some cases, suggest custom orthotics or night braces to prevent further malformations.

**Ingrown Toenails** - Ingrown toenails often are the result of trimming your toenails too short, particularly on the sides of your big toes. Children often bite their nails or peel off the tips, resulting the edges of the nail grow back down into the nail bed. Ingrown toenails start out hard, swollen and tender, and later, may become sore, red and infected. Your skin may start to grow over the ingrown toenail. Soaking your foot in warm, soapy water several times each day is usually a good way to treat an ingrown nail. We recommend that you visit our offices and let a podiatrist determine the best course of treatment for your condition.

**Fungal Infections** - Many people don't realize they have a fungal nail problem. Moreover, many people that do never seek treatment. Still, toenail fungus and fungal toenail infections are a common foot health problem. Fungal toenail infections can persist for years without ever causing pain. The disease, characterized by a change in a toenail's color, is often considered nothing more than a mere blemish, but it can present serious problems if left untreated. Some tips to prevent toenail fungus include keeping your feet clean and dry, wearing shower shoes in public facilities whenever possible, also avoid wearing excessively tight hosiery, which promotes moisture. Socks made of synthetic fiber tend to "wick" away moisture faster than cotton or wool socks, especially for those with more active lifestyles. Depending on the type of infection you have, over-the-counter liquid antifungal agents, while sometimes effective, may not prevent toenail fungus or a fungal infection from recurring. A topical or oral medication may need to be prescribed, and the diseased nail matter and debris removed by a process called debridement.
