Pedorthist vs. Podiatrist

What is the difference?

Pedorthist

- Areas of Practice: Foot orthotics and orthopaedic footwear. Pedorthists are specifically trained in the assessment of the foot and lower limb, the design, manufacture and fitting of custom foot orthoses, and footwear modifications, such as shoe lifts.
- Services Provided: Comprehensive foot assessments, Custom foot orthotics, modifications to orthotics, footwear modifications, orthopaedic footwear fitting, Off the shelf orthotics (non-custom), custom toe spacers, Bunion splints, Plantar Fasciitis Splints
- Training and Education: Courses on footwear fitting, lower extremity orthotic design, manufacture and materials, shoe construction and modification, and patient and practice management. Upon completion of their coursework, they are required to complete 1,000 hours of practical experience. The final stage is passing the examination board.
- Unlike a lot of podiatry groups, we have our very own pedorthist on staff to provided all footwear assessments!

Podiatrist

- Areas of Practice: The assessment of the foot and the treatment and prevention of diseases, disorders or dysfunctions of the foot by therapeutic, orthotic or palliative means. Podiatrists may also communicate a diagnosis to their patient and perform surgical procedures on the bones of the foot.
- Services Provided: Comprehensive foot assessments, Skin and nail care, surgical procedures on the subcutaneous and bony tissues of the foot, and assess for/design custom foot orthotics.
- Training: 4 year Undergraduate degree and Doctor of Podiatry Medicine degree (DPM)
- Certification/Credentials: Doctor of Podiatric Medicine (DPM)
- Overall, NextStep has 11 podiatrists on staff throughout all 11 of our clinics.
